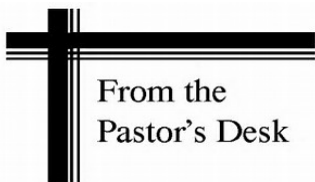

From the
Pastor's Desk

*"Then Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel and Jeshua son of Jozadak set out to rebuild the house of God in Jerusalem; and with them were the prophets of God, helping them."
Ezra 5:2*

Christmas has come and gone and the new year is upon us. If you are anything like me, you are now working to get life back to normal. There is some sadness in that. The decorations have to be put away, the family goes home and the food has to be cleaned up. Christmas is over and now we have to go about rebuilding the normal life that was interrupted for a season.

The book of Ezra is a story of the Israelites having to return to normal life. When the book begins, the Israelites have just been released from the Babylonian captivity. They were allowed to return home but there was a small problem. Home had been destroyed. Normalcy was no more. Everything that was before was gone. Most importantly the temple had been annihilated. The Israelites realized that in order to get back to life, they needed to rebuild the temple. They needed that sense of purpose and direction, and they also needed a visible reminder of God's presence. It would mean nothing for them to go on with life and yet not remember the God that had brought them this far. So, they set about rebuilding the temple. I love the last line because it wasn't that they rebuilt it as individuals, but everyone helped. All of the people gathered together and helped to rebuild life.

For some of us rebuilding after Christmas is easy. It is simply a matter of putting up the decorations and that is it. But for many, this can be a difficult time of year. Parents have to get into routine with their kids, health issues that were ignored during the holidays are now important again, Christmas bills are coming in and there doesn't appear to be an end in sight. For many we can understand what the Israelites went through when they realized that normal had been destroyed. But as a church family we have the blessing of being in it together. We get to help each other rebuild. So I encourage you, look around, pay attention for people that are having a harder time rebuilding and be there for them. Lift them up, pray for them, offer what assistance you can as we all look to rebuild normal together.

I invite you to join us in worship during January as we work our way through the book of Ezra and learn from the Israelites about rebuilding life.
