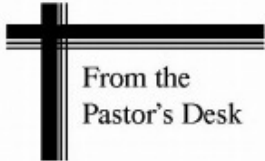

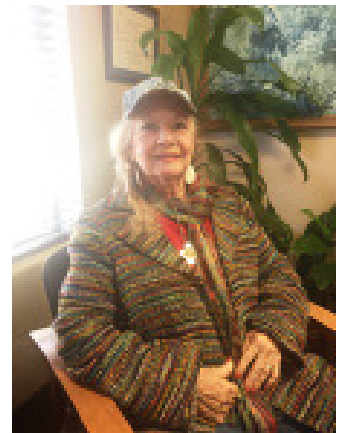

Newgate is a day mission that serves the spiritual, physical, social and emotional needs of the homeless, low income and marginalized population in Longview. Volunteers can help cook and serve meals, organize donated clothing, or help teach different classes that are offered. The clients love to have folks sit and talk with them as they eat lunch. It is a moment to know that somebody cares.

They are in need of many things: backpacks (*they carry everything in a backpack and what is given them needs to fit in a backpack*), travel size hygiene products (*they can't keep deodorant and toothpaste on the shelves*), men's socks, men's clothing, small blankets, hats, gloves, scarves, and financial contributions.

Upcoming Newgate events: The Christmas Store, *Trunk or Treat*, and the Gobble Wobble 1K, 5K and 10K Walk or Run. Donations will be appreciated for Christmas Gift Bags to be given out after worship on Christmas Eve: blankets, travel size hygiene products, flashlights(men), nail "stuff", perfume (women).
